Scoutbook and Internet Advancement

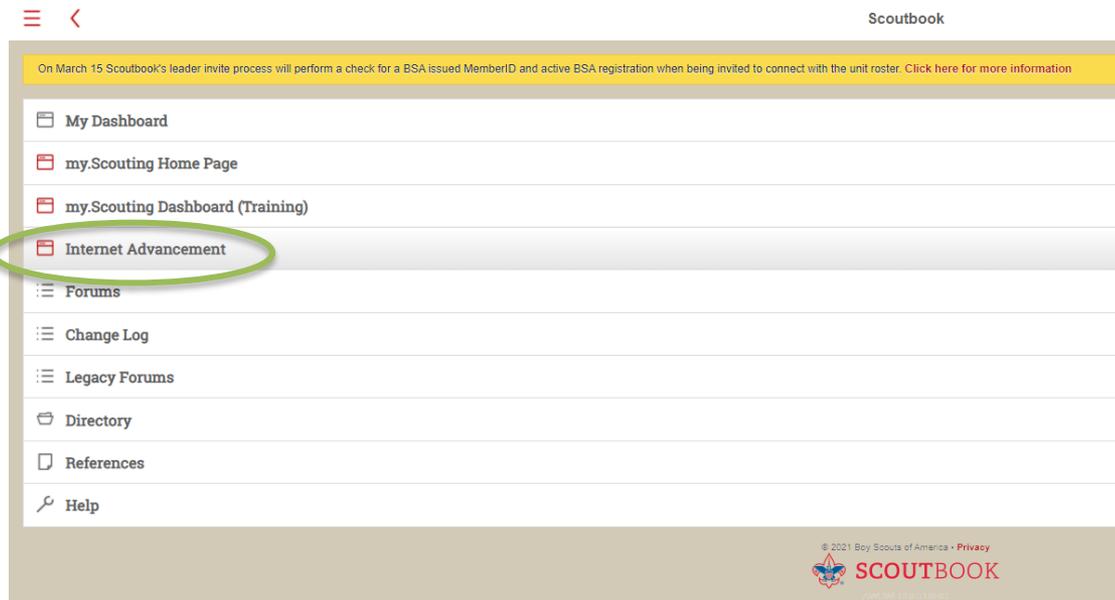

Navigating Internet Advancement

Here are a few helpful hints when viewing things in IA:

- Notice on the bottom you can select how many people you see on a page at a time. Increase this to the max people that you have so you aren't switching back and forth selecting people
- Towards the top there is a filter that says Show: Youth. Change this to Youth and Adults. You get credit for them as well.
